



## **Cedar Street Planters**

The City of Corning and the Gaffer District have partnered to refurbishing the four 1970's era concrete planters at the corner of Tioga Avenue and Cedar Street. The refurbished planters feature butterfly gardens, adding to the downtown's green space. These planters also serve as an outdoor classroom for area student groups to learn about the life and migration of butterflies in an easily accessible space.

Custom signage will welcome visitors and residents to this heavily trafficked and visible gateway to our City's historic district. Discussion is also underway to feature historical photos and interpretive signage. This is an opportunity to support a long-term, sustainable effort to both beautify downtown Corning while adding a new educational element.
