



Electronic Calendar

Since 1997, the City of Corning has been providing a calendar to residents to help them understand the scheduling of Public Works services. The content of this calendar has grown past Public Works services and now includes tips on recycling, public safety information, flood protection, meeting dates, etc.

The City traditionally produced 4,000 paper copies of the calendar. In 2010, the City Manager's Office began posting the calendar electronically on the City's website. The City now produces approximately 200 paper calendars to distribute upon request to senior citizens who have limited or no internet access.
